- Late Model: \$75 ~ Modified: \$25
- \$20 transponder fee if you need to rent one. We use the MyLaps/AMB transponders.
- A valid DIRTcar membership is mandatory. If you do not have one, we will be selling them for \$135.

MARS Late Model Championship Powered by FK Rod Ends & MARS Modified Championship Powered by Summit Racing Equipment Format

- Qualifying – Late Model – 2 Lap Qualifying
 - Modified – Your hot laps are your qualifying – 3 Laps
 - Straight Up Qualifying – (31 cars and less)
 - A & B Group Qualifying – (32+ cars)
 - Late Models will run transponders on the Left Front where the bumper meets the frame. Modifieds will run transponders on the right rear axle tube.
 - Overall Fast Qualifier on front stretch immediately following qualifying. (time permitting)
- Heat Races – Car count determines the number of heats – 8 Laps
 - 3 Heat Races – Top 5 transfer to A-Main (Top 5 scale) (31 cars and less)
 - 4 Heat Races – Top 4 transfer to A-Main (Top 4 scale) (32-47 cars)
 - 6 Heat Races – Top 2 transfer to A-Main (Top 2 scale) (48+ cars)

- Redraw
 - o Will be taken place at the series command center or at the scales. Drivers will be notified at the drivers meeting and over the driver one-way radio on where the location will be for that night.
 - o 3 Heats – Top 2 to Redraw. They will Redraw 1-6.
 - o 4 Heats – Winners to the Redraw
 - o 6 Heats – Winners to the Redraw
- B-Main(s) – Car count determines the number of B-Mains – 10 Laps
 - o 1 B-Main – Top 5 transfer to A-Main (Top 5 to scale) (31 cars and less)
 - o 2 B-Mains – Top 2 transfer to A-Main (Top 2 to scale) (32-47 cars)
 - o 2 B-Mains – Top 4 transfer to A-Main (Top 4 to scale) (48+ cars)
- Provisionals
 - o (2) series provisionals will be added to the field each night. Provisionals will go to the (2) highest drivers in series points.
 - o A maximum of (2) provisionals are available to the track at their expense to be added onto the tail of the standard 22 car starting field.
- Feature Event – Late Models – 30 Laps ~ Modifieds – 25 Laps
 - o Top 3 finishers to infield for Victory Lane interviews & photos.
 - o Top 5 to scales.
 - o All cars subject to post race tech at series officials' discretion if needed.
